Response

London Cycling Campaign strongly supports making the experimental Streetspace scheme along the A21 from Lewisham to Catford permanent. The scheme should stay in place until a permanent scheme is designed and implemented. The current changes make this busy section of the A21 safer for people cycling.

LCC fully agrees with Lewisham Cyclists' more detailed response to the consultation. For specific and detailed feedback on the proposals, please see their response.

If made permanent we think the entire corridor should be made 20mph (this was not implemented as planned), a safe cycle and pedestrian crossing should be installed between Mount Pleasant Road and Albacore Crescent, and that the left turn onto Morley Road be banned, as outlined in the Lewisham Cyclists response.
